Should candidates have experience (past or present) in the sector, this is converted into credits in the "Laureare l'esperienza- Award experience" project.

## DEGREE COURSE PROFILE

The degree course is designed to prepare students for work in education and professional training, both in schools and every other context of social life, and with every age group and all cultural and social levels.

## OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

The course is taught through lectures, seminars and laboratory practicals in the disciplines of psycho-pedagogy, social-healthcare, science-methodology, law, history-geography and language-literature; the course also gives students the possibility to learn at least one other language (written and oral) of the European Union and the necessary skills for information management and communication. Periods of teacher training in public and private social structures having an agreement with the LUMSA are an integral part of the course.

## OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMMES

### **Adult educators and experts in education process**

The course is designed for those who intend to work in public and private structures in the promotion and development, monitoring and assessing of courses for adult education.

### **Childhood educators**

The course is designed to prepare a professional figure expert in the education sector, with specific competences relative to growth processes and social and family problems of minors from 0 to 3.

### **Community educators**

The course teaches the necessary skills to work in the education and professional training sector in the social context and to teach and coordinate people who are either maladjusted or in danger of being so.

### Adult educators and experts in education processes

Public and private social structures for regular and permanent adult education in particular.

### Childhood educators

Day and residential services and structures for minors from 0 to 3 years old (nursery schools, crèches, play centres, care homes) ; domiciliary services and children's entertainment.

### Community educators

Public and private social-educational centres, homes for minors, prisons, first-aid centres, assistance for the disabled, mental health services and centres, family and territorial structures, centres for the elderly.

## SYLLABUSES

The course is taught through lectures regarding the following subject areas:
