## PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

**Consultant in judicial questions:** the consultant collaborates as an expert in the identification of signatures and contested writings (wills, bills of exchange, cheques, anonymous letters); examines writings that are the subject of contestation and verification with those of comparison supplied by the magistrates, lawyers and private persons in criminal and civil proceedings; participates in court hearings.

**Consultant in clinical neuropsychological questions:** the consultant collaborates with other professionals in the clinical field: clinical psychologists, neurologists, psychiatrists, professional educators and experts, through the recognition of alteration in handwriting correlated with the principle neuro-psychiatric syndromes with modifications of the cognitive and behavioural sphere in adults and children.

**Labour consultant:** the consultant collaborates with other professional figures in the recruitment and management of human resources, the training of groups and the giving of tasks. Collaborates in the choice of studies and careers.

## PROGRAMME

The Master gives the suitable cultural and scientific knowledge, practical methods and techniques of application necessary for the level of skills required by the professional area of graphological consultancy.

In particular the course gives the specific skills for the understanding of the personality by means of the tested techniques of the Moretti handwriting disciplines.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> level degree from the new system, university diploma, degree from the old system, or a degree from a foreign university recognised as being equivalent.

## STRUCTURE

- Maximum number of students: 25
- Minimum number of students: 20
- Total number of hours in course: 1,500 divided into 400 hours in the lecture hall, of which 135 hours of theory and 265 dedicated to the practical applicative methodology of professional consultancy.
- Assessment tests
- Final exams: written paper, on a subject chosen from one of the three professional areas.

## DIDACTICS

The strong point of the Master is to be found in its didactic innovation, both from a theoretical and practical applicative point of view. The decade of teaching experience in the university diploma course and the Graphological Consultancy degree course has made it possible, in fact, to review

the teaching methods directed at learning the subject of graphology with immediacy, according to strictly logical and consequential terms, independent of the grounding and cultural background of

the student. The excellent results of the previous editions confirm the effectiveness of the theoretical applicative methodology adopted in this Master.

University lecturers, experts in Moretti graphology with both academic titles and consolidated professional and scientific experience.
