## PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Professional able to work in the services companies (sectors: legal-administrative, strategic planning, relations with the regulator, new business, consumer relations), in the Civil Service (sectors: organisation, planning, policy, contract control and management), in the regulation authorities and in consultancy companies working in the services field.

## PROGRAMME

The Master develops the skills for the institutional-economic analysis of the services markets, the regulation, the technical-juridical questions linked to the processes of liberalisation and the management of public services and connected infrastructures.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Specialist degree, a degree of the old system or a degree from a foreign university recognised as being equivalent.

## APPLICANTS

Graduates in the juridical, economic, humanistic and scientific disciplines; professionals working in the sector.

## STRUCTURE

- Maximum number of students: 60
- Minimum number of students: 25
- Total number of hours in course: 1,500 divided into 300 hours in the lecture hall (divided into lectures, seminars and practical exercises)
- Assessment tests during course and final exams.
- Internship

## LECTURERS

University lecturers, magistrates, lawyers, managers working in the public services sector.

## SYLLABUS

The syllabus is divided into a general part, with teaching modules on the subjects of law, economics, and the regulation of public services, and into a special part with modules dedicated to a more detailed study of specific sectors of public utility.
