DEGREE COURSE PROFILE

The degree course in Law teaches students a vital understanding of the general legal disciplines and gives them an ethical-social education enabling them to acquire indispensable information and instruments for the legal profession. In particular, the course follows a scientific professional project aimed at developing the lawyer's professional training in the most topical and interesting legal subjects in the practice of law, in a European and international perspective.

OBJECTIVES OF THE DEGREE COURSE

- Precision in the analysis and combined reading of juridical norms
- Ability to set out, in writing and orally and in an appropriately technical language, the processes of reasoning and argument regarding general and specific legal matters
- Possession of the cognitive instruments and the interpretative techniques in order to pass from the observation and the analysis of the matter and concrete cases to reconstruct the defined question of law, with full knowledge of the sources and methods of juridical research.
- Full awareness of the cultural and practical implications of technical-juridical value, connected with the legal matters being dealt with
- Command of English, with particular reference to legal lexicon
- Ability to communicate with members of the legal profession from other legal systems
