REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESS

- Secondary school diploma or any equivalent diploma obtained abroad having the same validity.
- Restricted entry
- Admission to the degree course is subordinate to an interview in the Faculty and an entry test

DEGREE COURSE PROFILE

The degree course in Psychological Sciences and Techniques is designed to give students sufficient knowledge of the basic psychological disciplines needed for a good understanding of the methodological and technical instruments of psychological analysis and intervention.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

- Acquisition of the basic knowledge of the different sectors of psychology disciplines
- Acquisition of knowledge relative to the methods and procedures of scientific investigation
- Acquisition of the operative and applicative competences in services aimed at persons, groups, organisations and communities

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMMES

Psychology of Development and Rehabilitation

Study of the dynamics of socialisation of individuals and groups in schools and education centres; application of the diagnosis, intervention and research techniques to the development processes; programming and definition of assistance and rehabilitation of individuals with handicaps or with learning and socialisation problems.

Occupational Psychology and the Psychology of Organisations

Application of the diagnosis, intervention and research techniques to the behaviour of individuals and groups in organisations and in the workplace; application of techniques relative to the identification, the quantitative and qualitative measures and the treatment of problems in areas such as the management of resources and the diagnosis of the principle parameters of organisational functioning.

Clinical and Community Psychology

Application of psycho-diagnostic techniques and consultancy to individuals, couples, families and groups requiring assistance in difficult situations in the cognitive, affective and psycho-social spheres; management of crisis situations of adaptation problems over a life span and collaboration with other workers dealing with serious psychological problems.

CAREER OPENINGS

Psychology of Development and Rehabilitation - Clinical and Community Psychology

The career openings for graduates in these syllabuses are in rehabilitation, functional re-education and the social integration of people with disabilities, and also the possible collaboration with psychologists in the realisation of psycho-educational interventions and work aimed at integration and social participation.

Occupational Psychology and the Psychology of Organisations

Career openings are to be found in the realisation of educational projects to promote the development of the potential of individual growth and social integration and the application of protocols for professional integration, for the selection and assessment of human resources.

PROFESSIONAL PROFILES

Specialists in the psycho-social, ergonomic fields, psychometric assessment, human resources management, professional training, assistance and healthcare promotion.
