## AT A GLANCE

The Department of Human Studies is an innovative centre for study and scientific research, offering undergraduate and graduate courses in

- **Communication**
- **Education**
- **Letters and Italian Studies**
- **Psychology**
- **Teacher Training**

The driving force of the Department is the Faculty, more than 100 full-time and part-time teachers, including professors, adjuncts, lecturers, and post-doctoral researchers.

The main premises of the Department are located in a historical 19th century building in the Borgo Pio district, near St. Peter's Square and in the very heart of Rome.

## TEACHING

The Department offers courses for undergraduate and graduate students.

Students can pursue Ph.D. programs in:

- Communication, intercultural studies and complex organizations
- Theories, history and methods in education
- Cognitive sciences, rehabilitation and learning processes
- Psychology of work and human resources management.

The School of Journalism, founded in the '90s, allows a qualified access to the profession. It is one of the few academic centres recognized by the National Association of Italian Journalists.

In connection with professional communities and the world of business and non-profit organizations, the Department offers modules and professional degrees.





## RESEARCH

The synthesis between teaching and research is fundamental to LUMSA University. All the academic staff are involved in basic and applied research. The Department has won and managed a great number of projects of excellence at an Italian level, such as PRINs, Research Projects of National Interest awarded by the Ministry of Scientific Research. On a European level, it has been project leader or partner in the LLP Programme, Erasmus, Leonardo, Grundtvig, Joint-Actions, Intensive Programme, Youth in Action and Daphne project.

Consultancy and professional training are developed for public institutions, private companies, third sector organizations, and the local communities.

## INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

LUMSA University welcomes visiting professors and international students from all over the world. It has signed Erasmus agreements with 153 European universities.

In an intellectually lively environment, high-caliber teachers prepare students to give their best, foster their creativity and enter the world of work with a high level of professionalism.

LUMSA University has been awarded by the European Commission with two Labels of excellence: the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) Label and the DS (Diploma Supplement) Label.

## RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

Students have access to a variety of resources which meet their needs efficiently and allow them to spend their academic life successfully. Libraries and DB resources, PC rooms, WiFi, radio and TV laboratories, housing services, and much, much more, are available for Italian and international students.

All students are offered opportunities for one-on-one, small-group interaction with teachers. Financial aid programs from the Italian State as well as private donors ensure that talented students from all economic backgrounds can study at LUMSA. In the Department of Human Studies, education is linked to values, and the development of the entire human person is a priority objective.



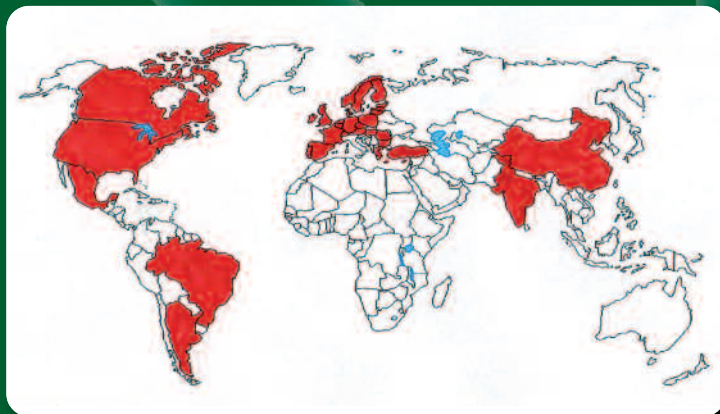
## LUMSA UNIVERSITY
