#### INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR ATTENDANCE OF THE FOURTH EDITION OF THE ANNUAL MASTER IN MANAGEMENT OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS A.Y. 2020-2021

# DECREE

#### Art. 1 – Aim

LUMSA University in cooperation with CANDRIAM and with FEEM (Fondazione ENI Enrico Mattei) offers ten (10) scholarships for the A.Y. 2020-2021 to Italian and international students.

Scholarships cover partially or totally tuition fees for the attendance of the Master in Management on sustainable Development Goals (MSDG) for the Academic Year 2020-2021 as follows:

1 excellence scholarship of	€ 9,000.00
3 advanced scholarships of	€ 7,000.00
6 partial scholarships of	€ 5,000.00

In case of additional donors, further partial scholarships (of €5,000.00) will be made available.

#### Art. 2 – Use

The Scholarship is assigned by reducing or covering the tuition fees and the amount cannot be converted to cash.

If the selected candidate does not complete the enrolment or the Master does not reach the minimum number of participants, the scholarship won't be assigned.

#### Art. 3 – Who can apply

Only students who will be admitted to MSDG are eligible to obtain MSDG Scholarships.

#### Art. 4 – How to apply

Candidates apply by flagging the specific box in the MSDG Application Form (<u>there</u> is no additional form to be filled up).

The award to foreign students is conditional on their obtaining the required VISA.







# Art. 5 – Assessment Criteria and Ranking

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the following selection criteria: Adherence of study path or graduate thesis to the MSDG topics;

Graduation vote;

Curriculum vitae;

Specific publications on the subject of sustainable development;

Other qualifications and certifications related to scholarships for international study programs (such as Erasmus), internships or language certifications.

Candidates admitted to the initial shortlist will be interviewed by Skype.

Grants will be awarded on the basis of the ranking based on merit.

The committee will complete its selection within the 30<sup>th</sup> of June, 2020.

The ranking, which will include candidates' personal identifiers, and the score achieved, will be published on the MSDG website: <u>http://mastermsdg.lumsa.it/</u>

# Art 6. – Selection Committee

The selection Committee will be made up of three members chosen among teaching staff and Members of the MSDG Committees (Management, Scientific, Steering).

#### Art 7. – Incompatibility

The scholarship is incompatible with any other one supplied by Italian public organizations or by LUMSA University.

# Art 8. – Deadline

The deadline is the 15<sup>th</sup> of June, 2020, midnight, Rome local time. The deadline for candidates applying <u>without scholarship</u> is the 15<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020,

midnight, Rome local time.

# Art 9. – Acceptance of MSDG Admission

Candidates awarded a scholarship will be notified by the 6<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020. They will have to formally subscribe the scholarship by paying a €500.00 acceptance fee, which will be deducted from the total fees, by the 27<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020.

Candidates admitted without scholarship will be notified by the 14<sup>th</sup> of August, 2020.

# Art 10. – Modality of the Master's Activities

MSDG has a blended format featuring three residential weeks of frontal lessons in Rome while the students perform the remaining activities remotely on our platform and at their own pace. If the fallouts of the current covid-19 emergency will require it, also the three residential weeks will be offered online on a live modality and the VISA requirements will be waved. Official communications will be provided at the appropriate time.
